Big Shoulders Fund will invest \$50 million in the 30 schools over the 10 year period. The investment is in ADDITION to the scholarships and support that is already being provided. This is a tremendous asset to our school, but it does not impact your current scholarships or tuition agreements.

What does this mean for MBTA? Big Shoulders will provide support to help us achieve goals in academics, enrollment, development, and finances. Our partnership will mean new programs for MBTA like a STEM/Engineering/Robotics Lab, new technology, resources for students and teachers, and additional teacher training.
